Content	Violent and armed conflicts over the distribution of and access to resources are currently among the greatest structural risks. The massive and limitless exploitation of resources is a major cause of environmental destruction, climate catastrophe, hunger, displacement and flight. The effects of these planetary crises affect regions and people around the world in very different ways. The seminar will use the experience and expertise of various experts in church development cooperation to examine the various regional, social and political consequences of resource overexploitation, as well as forms of resistance against it and the search for alternatives, using country examples. The interdependencies with Europe and international politics will also be examined. In each case, it will become clear that a socially just and ecologically sustainable use of resources requires comprehensive social change.
